Memorandum of Understanding between NHS Lothian and SAS dated 14 October 2024 ("MoU")

We are writing to you in relation to the above noted MoU and confirm the following variations to the MoU, such variations to take effect from the date upon which SAS countersigns this letter:

- (a) The following text from clause 2.1 of the MoU shall be deleted "31st of March 2025" and replaced with "31st of March 2026";
- (b) The detail in Appendix 2 of the MoU shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

Appendix 2: Annual running costs for access to Lifelines training materials

Maintenance of Lifelines Scotland website (domain name, hosting fee, 1 day a month of an assistant psychologist to monitor links) **£2,256 per year***

*These figures are a third of the total cost which will be split across SAS, PS/SPA and SFRS. If **Additional work** is required (to adapt materials, provide further training) it will be charged at £800 per day.
